



In Coloplast we acknowledge the concern on climate changes related to human activities and takes on responsibility for reducing the climate impact from our operations.

Our overall target is to continuously reduce emissions of green house gases through financially sustainable initiatives in operations under our direct control. To meet this, we are constantly setting up targets on relevant topics.

Targets:

Energy consumption¹

• 10% absolute reduction in greenhouse gases from energy consumption in our fiscal year 2013/2014 compared to the baseline period Mar. 2010 to Feb. 2011. This will result in a 25-35% reduction relative to our production output.

Air cargo

• Maximum 1.5% of our inbound distribution² will be air transports in 2013/2014 compared to 2.5% in 2010/2011. This will result in a relative reduction in greenhouse gas emissions from inbound distribution globally of 20-25%.

We have adopted the Greenhouse Gas Protocol as our green house gas calculation basis and we voluntarily disclose our full known green house gas inventory to the Carbon Disclosure Project and in our yearly Corporate Responsibility report. The overall responsibility for this policy lies with Coloplast's CFO, a member of Executive Management. The operational responsibility lies in Corp. Quality & Environment with the Director for Environment, Health & Safety Development. The policy will be evaluated annually.
